## Class 2 - Trip to Northampton Museum

Class 2 are going to Northampton Museum on **10th October 2024** to learn about the importance of the shoe trade in Northampton and the role that children played in factory work. ## Term Topics

This term's topic across the school is Northampton. Each class will be studying different aspects of this topic. In addition, Reception will also be focussing on learning about themselves as they settle into school.

### Reception "All about me"

The children will engage in a range of activities about themselves including their likes and dislikes their families, pets, homes and new friends. They will also be exploring the local area in connection with the Northampton topic.



### Class 1

Class 1 will be studying the geographical features of the town compared to the countryside. They will then explore the different sports played in the town focusing on Northampton Town Football Club and Northampton Saints Rugby Club.. They will study the famous players from these teams.



### Class 2

Class 2 will be focussing on life in Northampton in the Victorian era, particularly the role of the children in the shoe industry at that time, and the challenges they faced.



### Class 3

Class 3 will be studying the history of Northampton and how it has expanded and developed over time. They will also study its geographic features and life in Northampton through the ages.
