Class 1 will be studying many different animals this term focussing on a different group of animals each week. These include farm animals, woodland animals, jungle creatures and the animals you can see while on safari.


Class 2 - Castles

Free School Meals and Pupil Premium

If you are in receipt of certain benefits you may be entitled to Free School Meals and Pupil Premium.

Those benefits are:-

- Universal credit provided you have a net income of £7400 or less.
- Income Support.
- Income-based Job Seekers Allowance.
- Income related employment & Support Allowance.
- Support under Part IV of the Immigration & Asylum Act 1999.
- The guaranteed element of state pension credit
- Child Tax Credit, provided that you are not also entitled to Working Tax Credit & have an annual gross income of £16,190 or less.
