Pupil Premium

If you receive any of the following benefits you may be entitled to Pupil Premium (additional funding for the school) :-

- Income Support.
- Income-based Job Seekers Allowance.
- Child Tax Credit Only (with income up to £16,190)
- with no element of Working Tax Credit.
- National Asylum Seekers Support.
- Guarantee element of State Pension Credit.
- Employment and support Allowance (income related)
- Universal Credit (income dependant).
